Made up of a DVD-Rom and practice guide, *Safe* includes sessions on important issues deaf children need to know about. Topics include feelings, relationships, differences, bullying and growing up (including sex education); safety indoors, outdoors and on the road; internet and mobile phone safety; and someone to turn to. Young deaf presenters present each of the topics on the DVD-Rom, and there are role plays (short films), storyboards, animations, a glossary of BSL terms and other learning resources to help you.
