

## A recipe for success

## Step 1

## Step 2

We've included a score sheet in this pack to help them rate those bakes, and a certificate for the winning baker to treasure forever (along with their bragging rights). Just make sure your fundraising is all wrapped up and on your JustGiving page by the end of May.

## Step 3
