How do I apply?

to fill in an application form by 20 January 2025. You will need to be available for a virtual interview with one of our friendly team members in January or February 2025.

What sort of things will I do?



- Take part in training to develop lots of important skills like campaigning, public speaking and more.
- Meet with decision makers at the NSPCC to share your ideas and opinions on the work we do.
- Meet with other members of the Young People's Board for Change to talk about the things that matter to young people.
- Represent the Young People's Board for Change at exciting events.

I've never been on an advisory board before. Can I still apply?

Don't worry, you don't need to have any previous experience of being on an advisory board, or with the NSPCC. There will be lots of fun training sessions to learn new things and develop your confidence. We're here to support you through every step of your journey.
