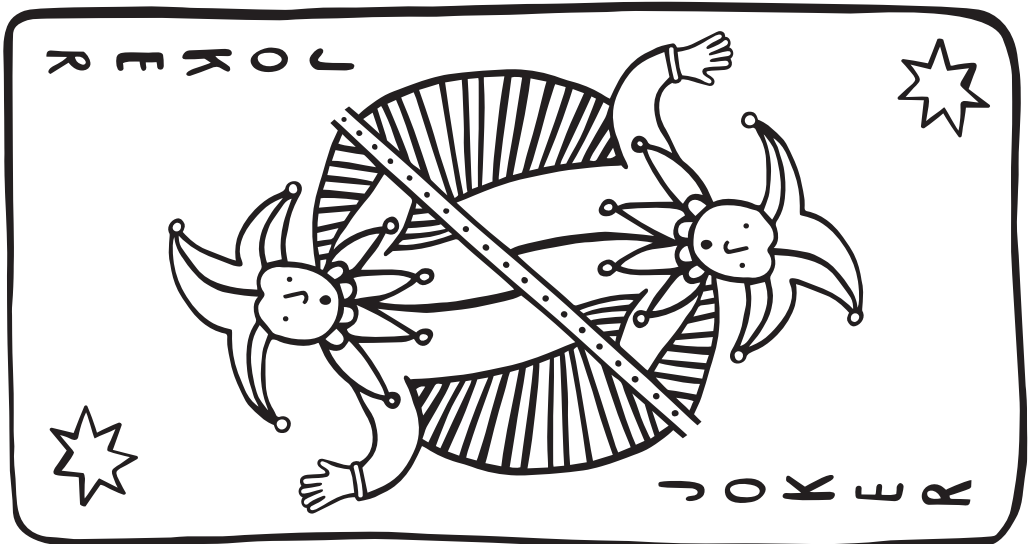

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Cheat sheet

- Skip a turn in Jenga.
- Avoid paying rent in Monopoly.
- Take an extra guess in Cluedo.
- Change the category in Trivial Pursuit.
- Nominate someone to take your turn in Twister.
- Make an opponent take a turn with their non-writing hand in Operation.
- Or make up your own rule!

How to use the Joker card

1 Before you start your game, you need to decide:

- how much players need to pay to use the card
- what advantage players will get from using it.

For example, if you're playing Monopoly, you might decide that players need to pay an extra £2 to avoid going to jail at a crucial moment.

2 To use the card, a player simply needs to say so, pick it up and keep the card for the duration of their turn. And pay of course!

3 Each player can only use the Joker card once per game.

4 You can make up your own Joker card rules, or pick from our cheat sheet. Have fun!
