Bobble Hat Day

CREATE YOUR OWN FESTIVE HAT TO WEAR ON BOBBLE HAT DAY.

Instructions

1. Use the template provided, or draw a semi-circle on a piece of festive coloured paper or card. Use the long edge of an A4 piece of paper as the base of your semi-circle.
2. Hold the two ends of the semi-circle together to make a nice cone shape. The more the edges overlap, the smaller your bobble hat will be.
3. Staple the ends together at the bottom of the hat, and try it on for size. If it's too big or small, just take out the staples, re-adjust, and then staple again. When you're as happy as an Elf at Christmas, glue along the seams and stick together.
4. Now to add a chinstrap. Simply punch a pair of opposite holes in near the bottom of the hat. Attach the ends of an elastic string around the holes. Now your hat won't blow away, even when you're riding the sleigh!
5. Make your Christmas hat extra Christmassy with festive stickers and glitter, or draw your own festive design. Add cotton wool to the bottom and top, and there you have it – your very own Santa bobble hat. Ho Ho Ho!
