

## MOVE A MILE FOR NSPCC'S CHILDHOOD DAY WITH YOUR PAPER DOG

### Teacher's Notes

**Read the separate activity sheet to the children or if appropriate let them read it themselves. Have a classroom discussion about how many different breeds of dog they can think of and what they look like; what dogs they have at home and what their dogs' names are; favourite breeds and favourite names for dogs.**

There are four dog templates to print out. The children can choose one to colour in, cut out and take on the Childhood Day Mile. Or they might like to draw their own. Stick to cardboard or the back of a cereal box and attach string for a lead. Enjoy your walk.

“My dog is wet; his paws are muddy!”

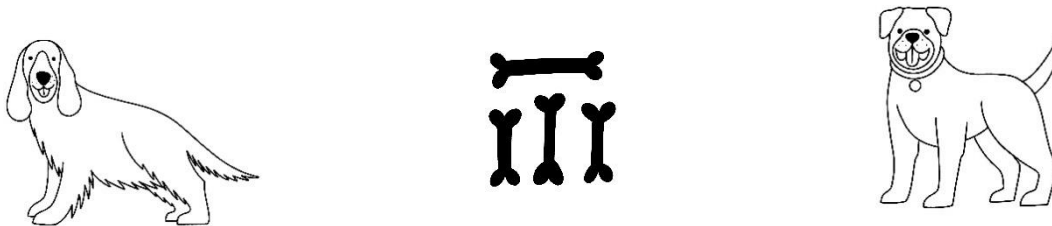
“My dog has turned into a kite!”



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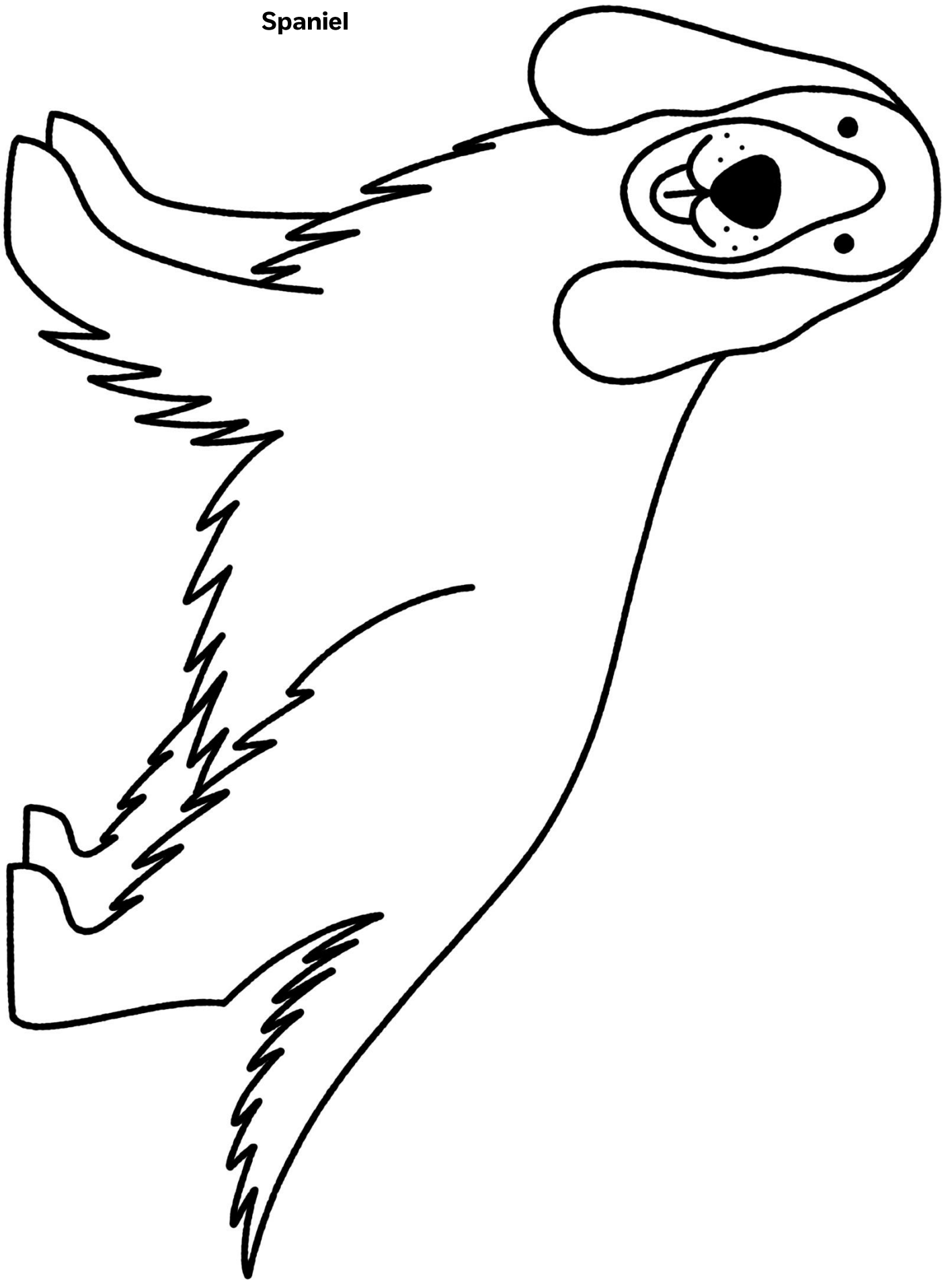

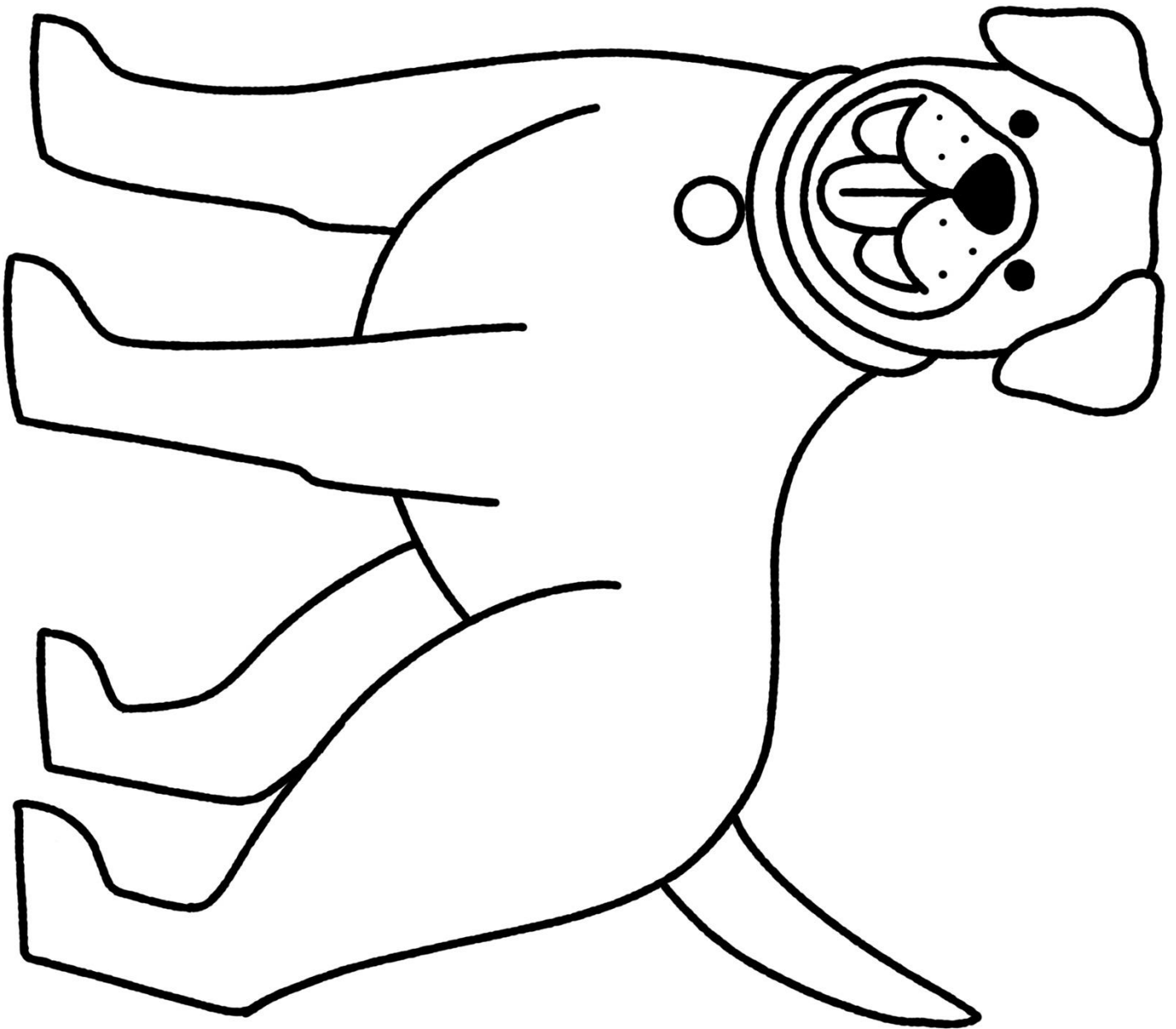

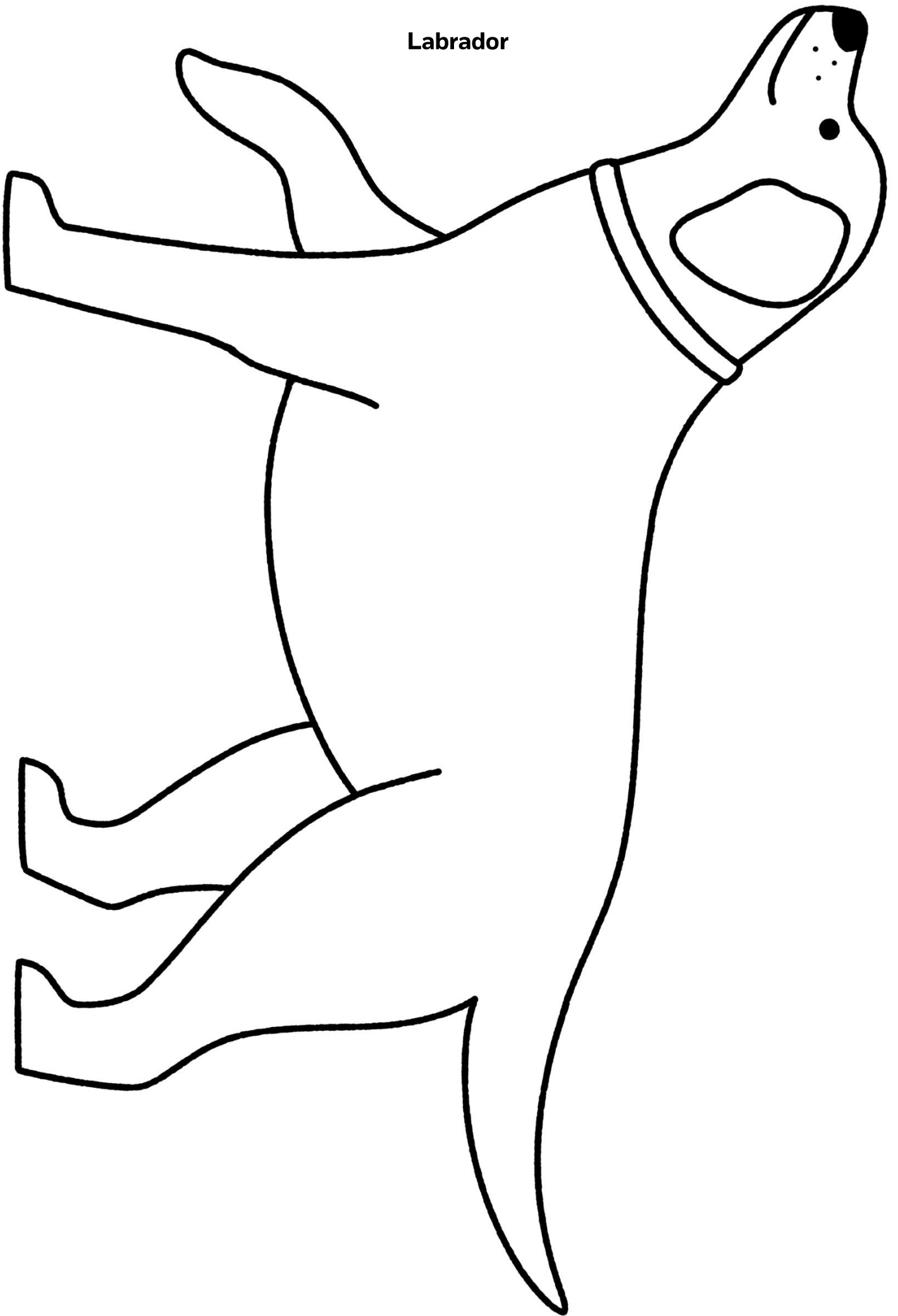
Spaniel
