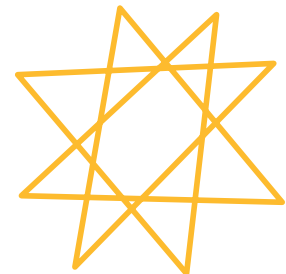
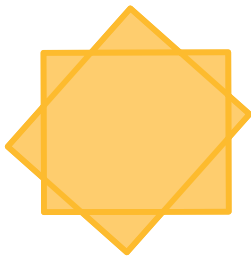
Wish upon a star

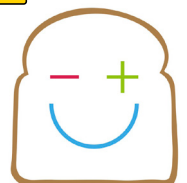
How many different stars can you draw? They could have different numbers of points, or be made of different shapes.

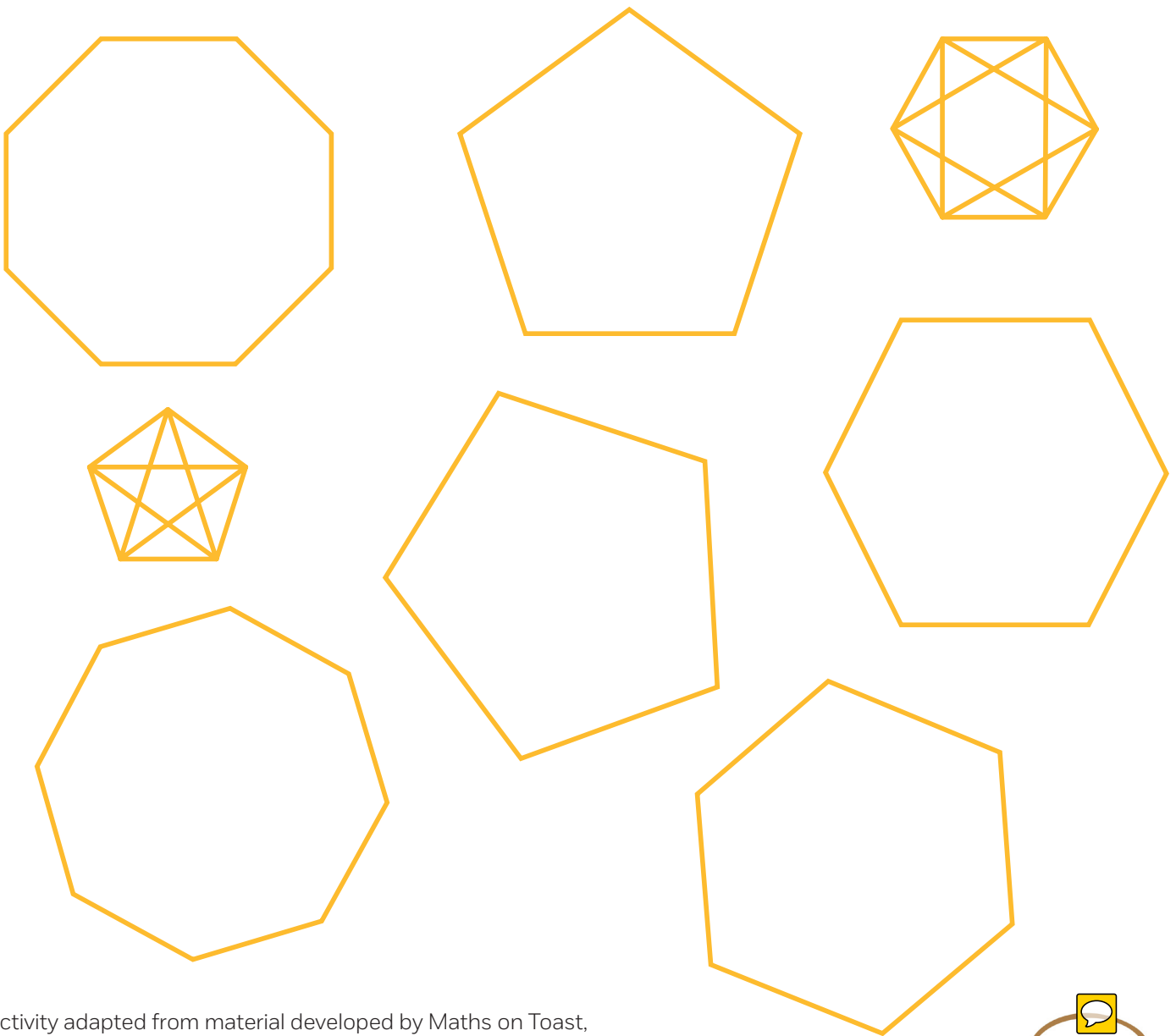
Wish upon a star – useful shapes to help

How many different stars can you draw? They could have different numbers of points, or be made of different shapes.

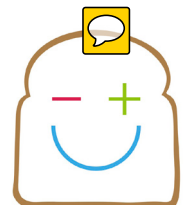
These shapes may help you to draw stars.
