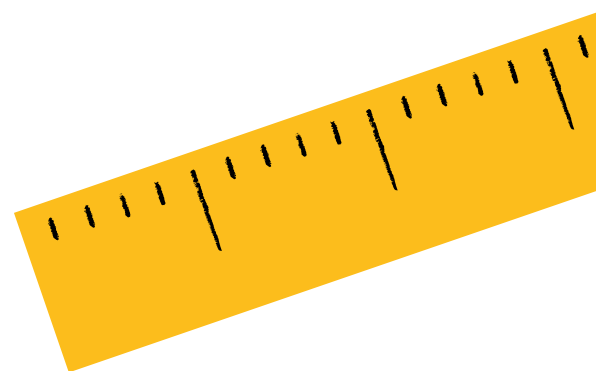
1. Can you make some new routes home using 3 different times tables?



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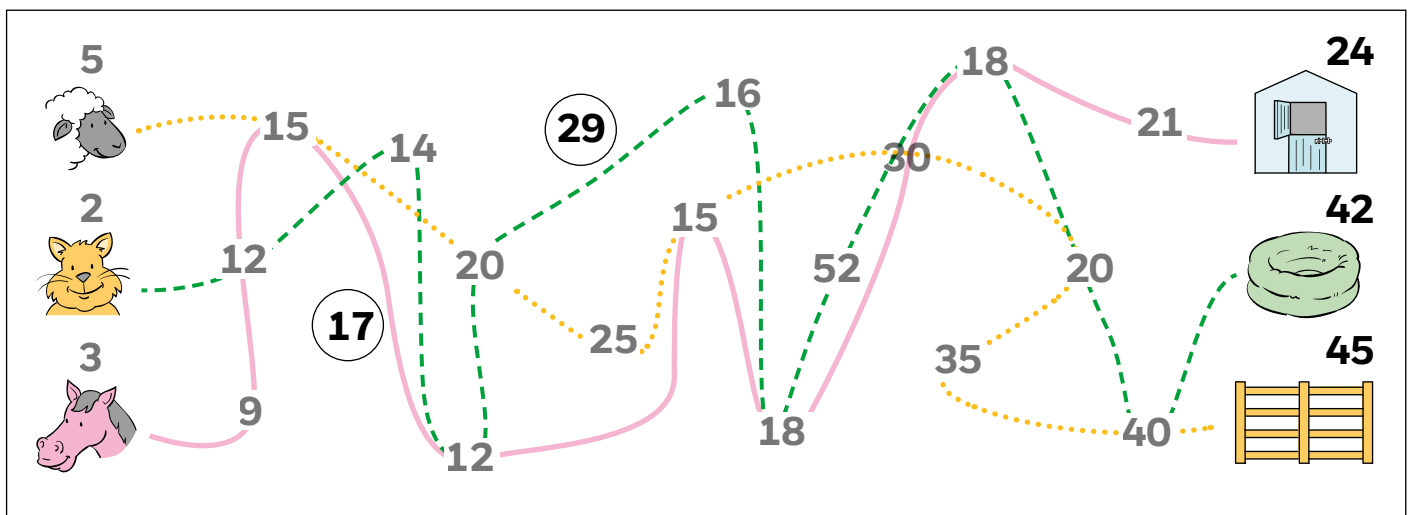
