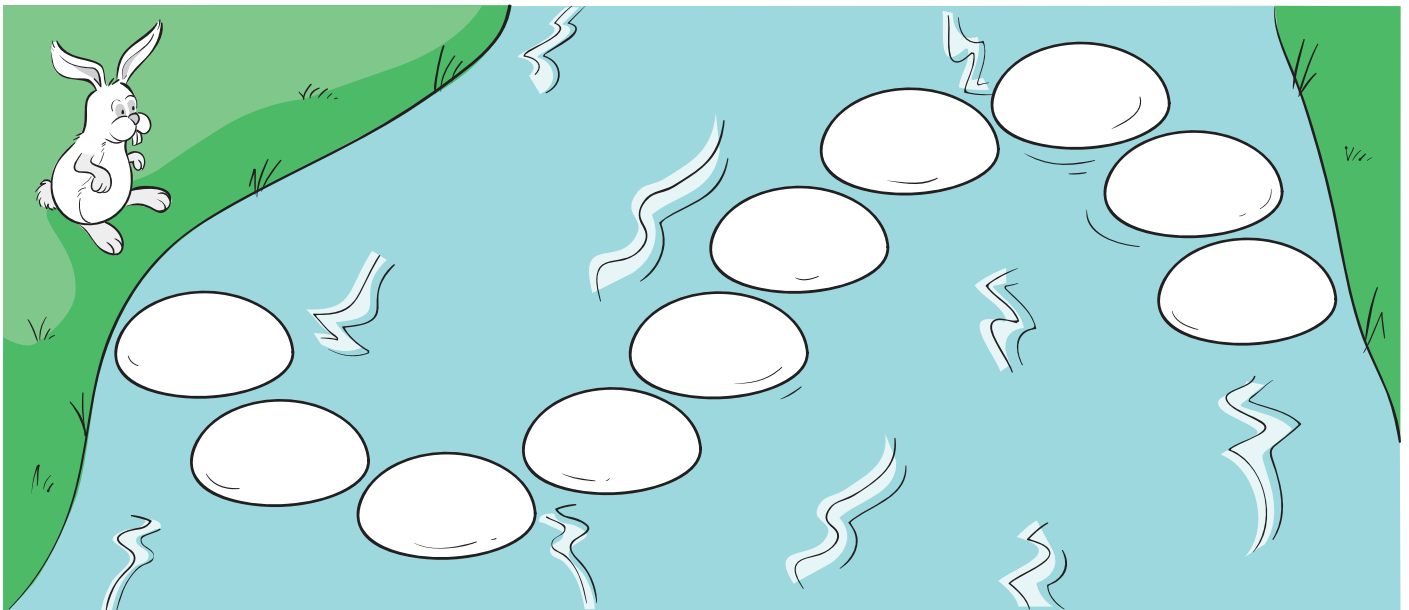
Activity:

1. How many hops will the rabbit take to cross the river?
2. Can you write a numeral on each stone?
Can you match the numeral to the Numicon Shape?
3. Think of two animals rabbit could meet when it crosses the river. Can you draw one on the second stone and one on the fifth stone?

Extra challenge:

With some friends, now cross your own river.

1. Use chalks to draw your own river on the ground and count how many hops it takes for you to cross.
2. Write down who crossed the river and in how many hops.
3. Who crossed the river in the smallest number of hops? Who crossed the river in the largest number of hops?

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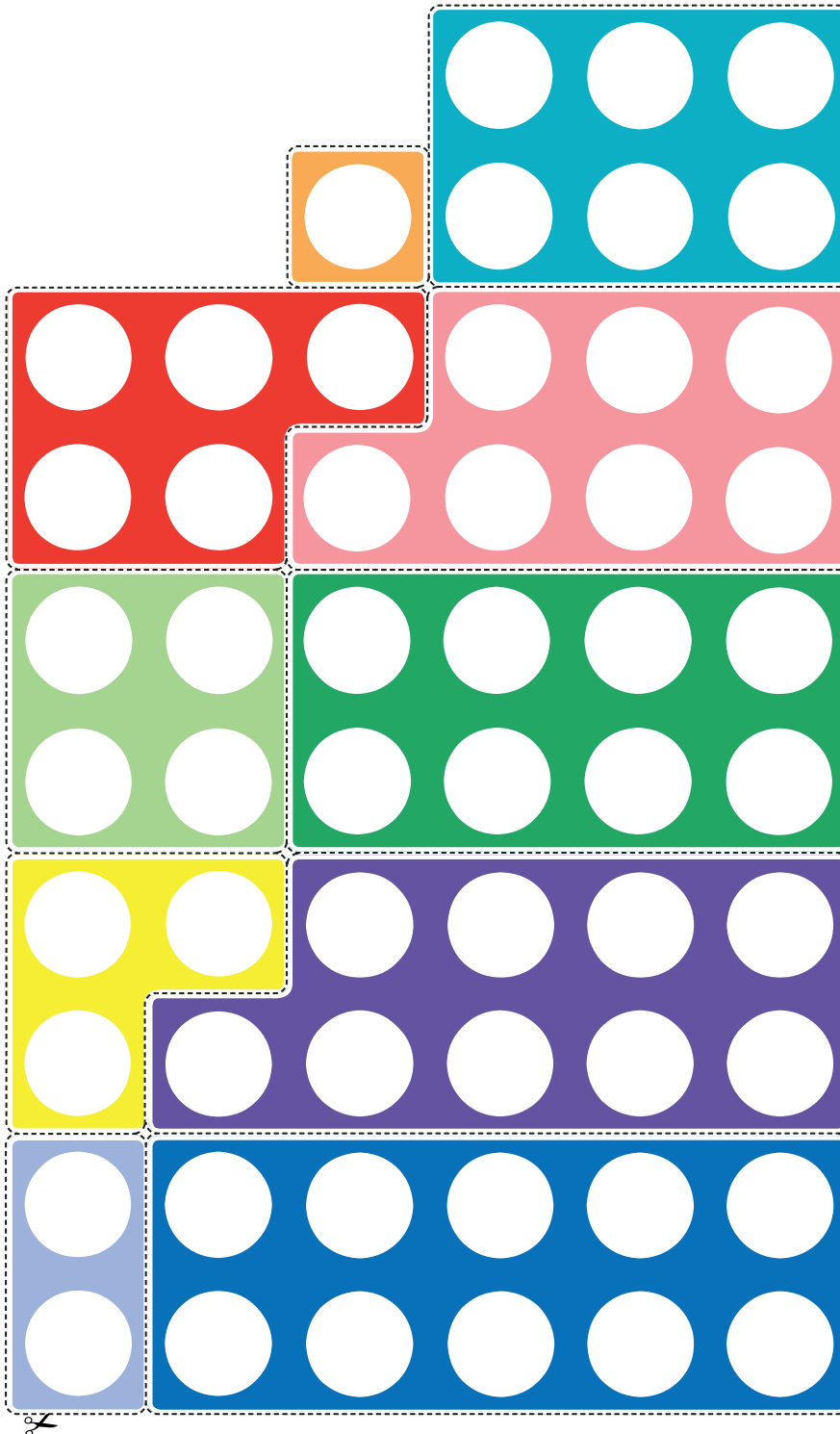

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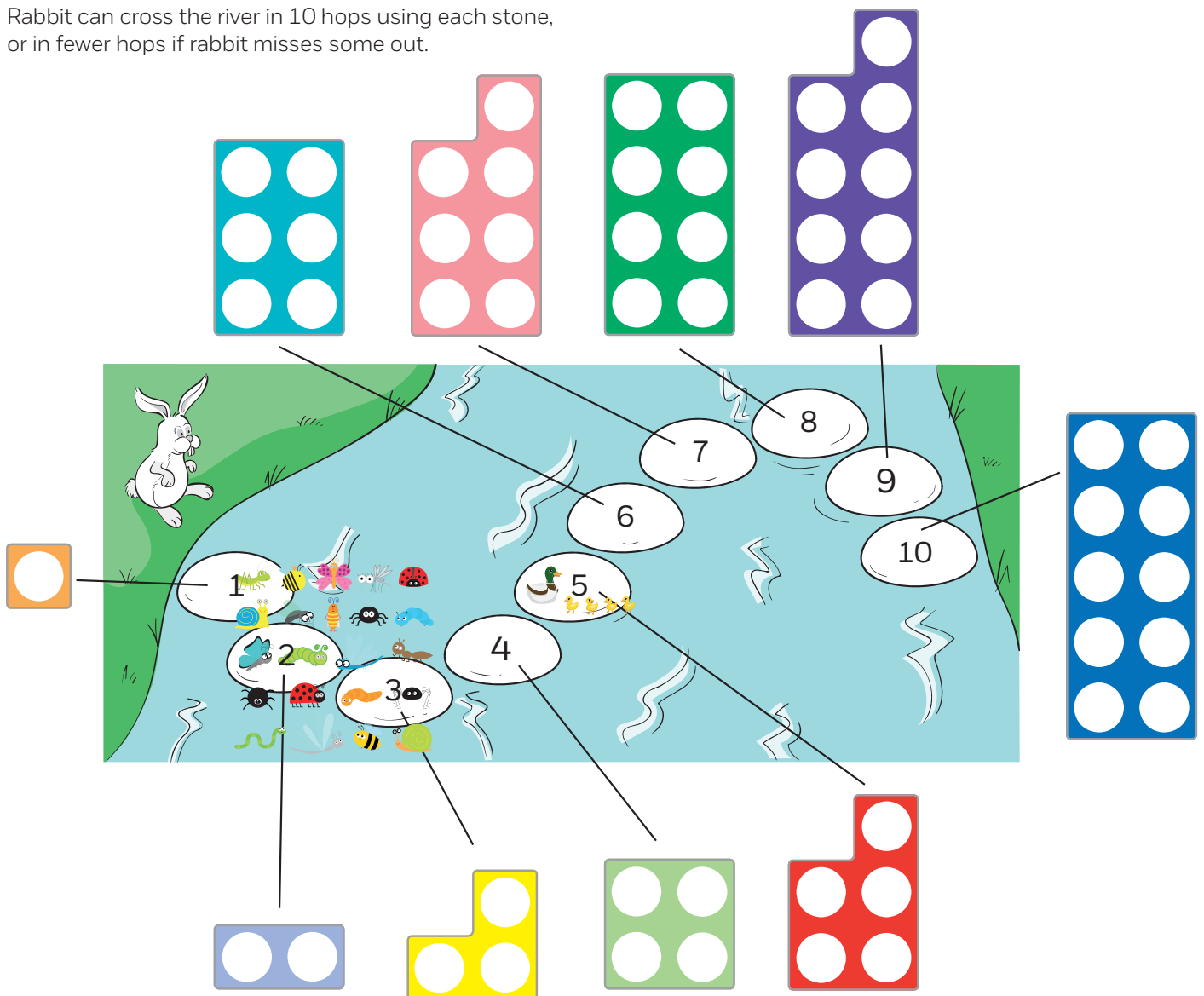
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TEACHER'S NOTES



Answers:

Rabbit can cross the river in 10 hops using each stone, or in fewer hops if rabbit misses some out.



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
