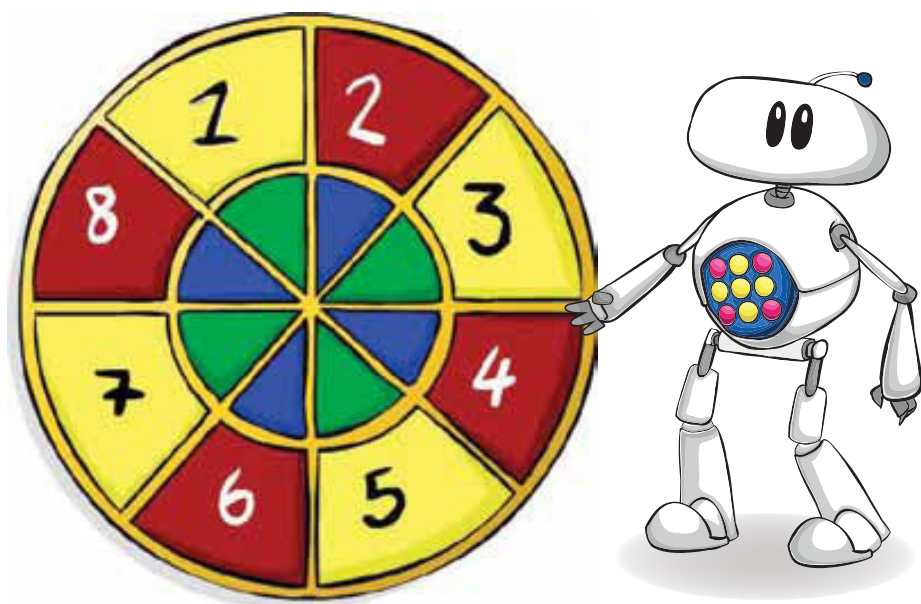
## How to raise money
