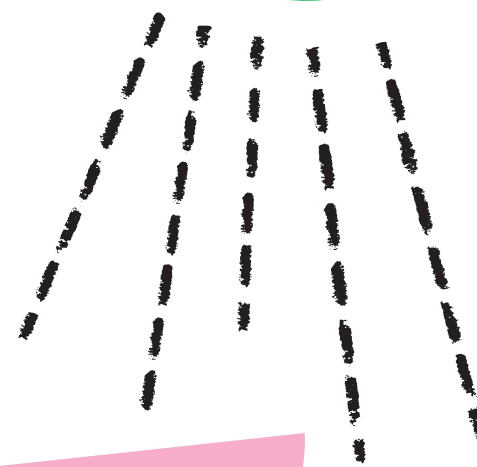
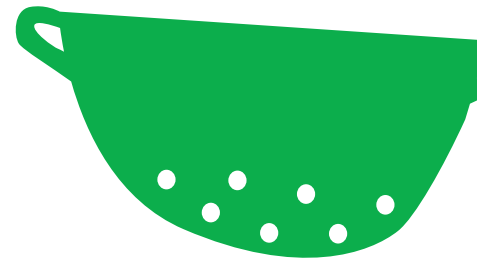
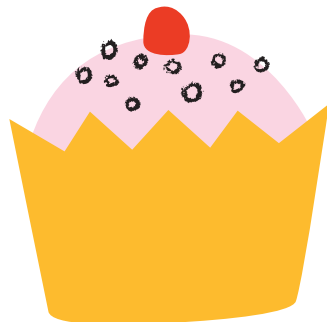
Fruit muffins – makes 12 muffins

You will need:

- 225g self-raising flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 50g brown sugar
- 175ml milk
- 75g butter (melted)
- 1 egg
- 200g chopped fruit

1. Mix together the flour, baking powder, sugar, milk butter and egg in a bowl until there are no lumps.
2. Mix in 200g of chopped fruit.
3. Spoon into greased muffin tins.
4. Bake at 200°C for 15-20 minutes or until golden brown.
