Create a Number Garden



Practise your times tables and number bonds.
Create a beautiful array of maths flowers.

Times Tables:

1. Create a flower using the template.
2. Choose a times table to practise and draw the number in the centre of one of your flower shapes. Number the petals 1–12. The numbers being multiplied are called **factors**. For example: $8 \times 5 = 40$
3. Now write the answers to the multiplications on the petals below. The result of the multiplication is called the **product**. For example: $8 \times 5 = 40$

Number Bonds:

Repeat the steps using the petals to display the pairs of numbers that are added to make the centre number. These numbers are called **number bonds**. For example: $9 + 1 = 10$ or $90 + 10 = 100$



Why is this maths?

You are exploring a creative way to practise and display times tables. Number bonds help you to understand how numbers work and can help you with addition, subtraction and times tables!
