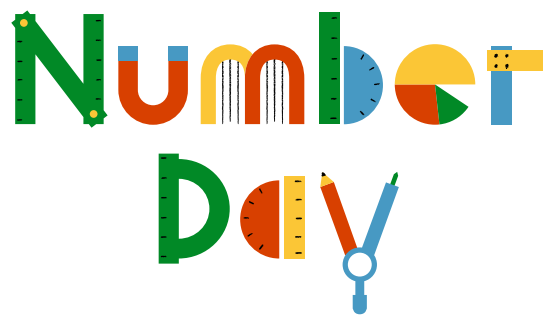

# Create a Number Garden



Practise your counting skills.  
Create a beautiful array of maths flowers.

## Counting:

1. Create a flower using the template.
2. Number the petals of your top flower 1-10.
3. Get active – work with your hands as well as your head! Use blocks or stickers to count out; or draw dots/pictures on the petals below.
4. You don't have to stick to the numbers 1 – 10.



## Why is this maths?

You are identifying numbers and building number sense as you count. These are important skills that help build confidence and get you ready for further maths learning.
