Why should you keep this information private?

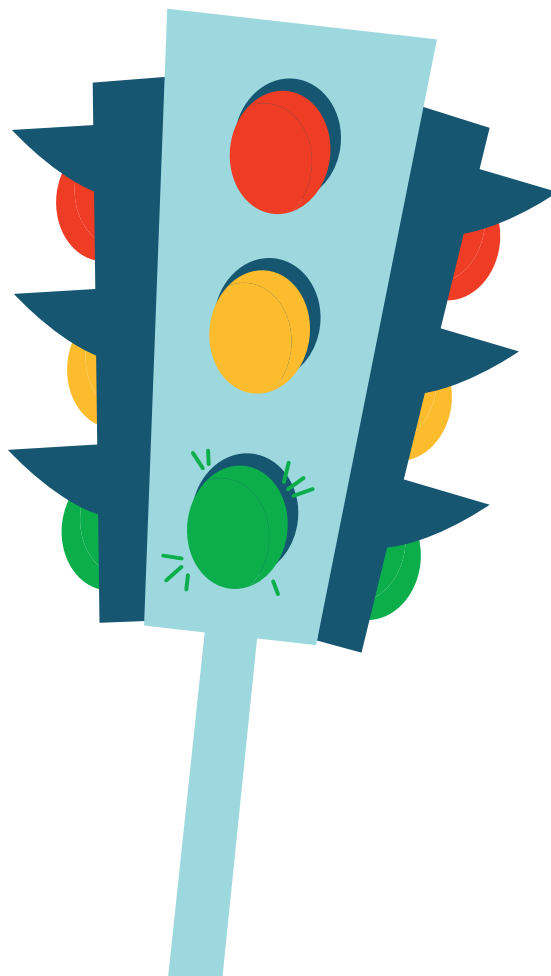
What should you do if someone else knows your password?

Traffic lights: Use the traffic lights on the next page to sort which information is safe to share, what can be shared in certain situations and what cannot be shared.

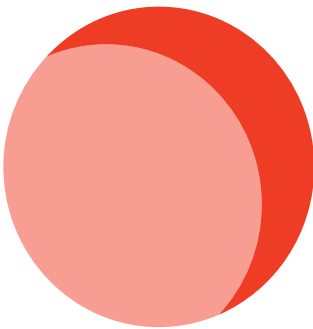
Remember: always talk with a trusted adult if you aren't sure about sharing your details.



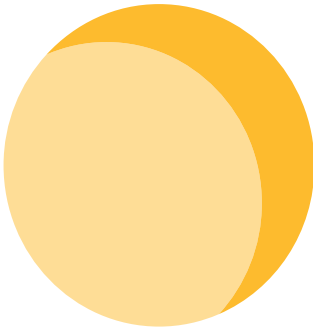
Sharing personal details

Use the traffic lights to sort the following information:

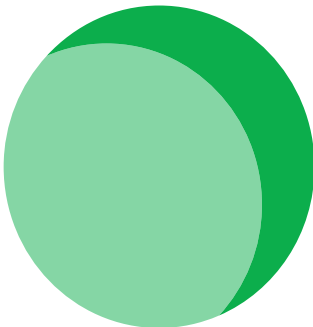
1. Usernames from other accounts
2. Date of birth
3. Current location
4. Email
5. Address
6. Name
7. Passwords
8. School
9. Phone number



Red is information that is never safe to share.



Yellow is information that can be shared in certain situations.



Green is information that's safe to share.
