Print out Halloween themed colouring sheets and offer these for a donation for children to take away and colour in.

### Pumpkin Carving Contest

A chance to get creative. Ask colleagues to enter their spooky designs for a small donation. Bring out your creativity and carving skills to transform ordinary pumpkins into eerie masterpieces. Offer a prize for the winning pumpkin and display them for everyone to see.

### Guess the weight of the pumpkin

Before the pumpkin carving starts, challenge your colleagues to test their skills in a 'Guess the weight of the pumpkin' competition! Everyone can take a guess at the pumpkin's weight and have the chance to win a fangtastic prize.
