What to do if you have concerns
about a child or a vulnerable adult

EVERY CHILDHOOD IS WORTH FIGHTING FOR

We all have a responsibility to safeguard children and vulnerable adults.

It's important to:

- **recognise** and **respond** to concerns about the welfare of a child or vulnerable adult
- **record** basic information
- **report** it without delay and within 24 hours.

If someone is at risk of immediate harm, call 999 then tell your NSPCC contact and the helpline on **0808 800 5000** or at **nspcc.org.uk/helpline**

If someone is **not** at risk of immediate harm, tell your NSPCC contact about your concerns and report to the helpline.
