Our direct work with children



We worked directly with **37 children and families**, delivering services such as, **Turn the Page** our **HSB service**, **Letting the Future In** and our **Sibling service**

Child Protection in Sport Unit



We supported **over 200 sporting Organisations** to develop and embed safeguarding policies, procedures and processes

Professional Learning Services



We delivered **training or elearning to 60,900** professionals across early years, education, local authorities, charity, voluntary and health sector

NSPCC Learning



We provided **information, resources and courses** for professionals and people working with children, there were **over 2.5 million visits** to our website

The NSPCC Helpline



The NSPCC Helpline responded to over **77,800 contacts** from people, across the UK, and Channel Islands with concerns about a child's welfare



When necessary, the **NSPCC Helpline** make **referrals** to local agencies like the police and children's services in Jersey

Child safety online



We are working to keep children safe online. This includes **campaigning**, and **support for parents**

Childline



Our Childline volunteers delivered around **170,000 counselling sessions** to children and young people



We estimate around **200** of these children lived in **Jersey**

Local campaigns



Jointly with the **Government of Jersey** and the **Safeguarding Partnership**, we launched an online harms campaign **'Be The First Filter'** developed with local children, parents and professionals

Supporting Schools



2,800 children in **14 schools** took part in our online **Speak out. Stay safe.** Programme. In addition to this, we also delivered face-to-face workshops in **15 schools** to **990 children**

Implementation Support



We have trained and worked with **partner organisations working together** to support children and families in **Jersey**

NSPCC Jersey delivered prevention work supporting children and families whilst increasing awareness of our work through building partnerships in the community
